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




Timely and comparable data on cancer burden across Europe

# In 2022, there were an estimated 16,000 new childhood cancer cases (age 0-19 years) diagnosed in the EU



# Challenges in childhood cancer data processing

- Ad hoc processing and classification (ICCC-3)
- Childhood are rare tumours, grouped dissemination
  - data protection issues
  - statistical instability
- High quality data needed for measuring childhood cancer burden
  - ✓ Ad hoc data validation software and multiple primary tumour selection routines




### **ECIS** as a JRC-ENCR collaboration





- Europe-wide standardised protocols for data collection and validation
- Aligned to and serving multiple projects
- Moving towards a rolling process with annual updates/submissions

- Collaboration agreement between the JRC and 150+ ENCR registries to structure roles in contribution to ECIS
- ECIS record in EC DPO register for accountability and transparency
